### GILA BEND AREA PUBLIC NOTICE

Public notice correction from the Town of Gila Bend Water Department.

The first CCR (Consumer Confidence Report) on the report published June 21, 2023. The Lead Information Statement should have read as follows.

Lead, in drinking water, is primarily from materials and components associated with service lines and home plumbing. If present, elevated levels of lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. The **Town of Gila Bend** is responsible for providing high quality drinking water, but cannot control the variety of materials used in plumbing components. When your water has been sitting for several hours, you can minimize the potential for lead exposure by flushing your tap for 30 seconds to 2 minutes before using water for drinking or cooking.
