

## **No Fly Zone, Gila Bend Airport**

Below are the mitigation measures that No Fly Zone Racing has implemented. This must be adhered to by all participants and compliance to these protocols should be administered by all participants and staff. Failure to comply with covid standards may result in removal from the event.

Event Located at Gila Bend Airport in Gila Bend

- All staff, volunteers and participants are required to wear masks throughout the event even outdoors, masks will be provided and enforced at the entrance when entering the races front entrance. Drivers will also be given designated areas to park.
- Participants are assigned an arrival briefing to check in for the event.
- Participants are required to be in the drivers briefing at 9 am the morning of the event.
- Participants must spread out six feet in all directions while waiting for their packet.
- Two check-in tables are six feet apart and are limited to five people per line.
- Lines are six feet apart with "X" on the ground to mark where people should stand.
- 6 foot separation is required during the day by everyone at the event (No Exceptions)
- After checking in, participants wait for the drivers meeting to start. There are no pre-race activities.
- Participants line up in the designated taxiway in their vehicles near runway 4.
- Drivers are not allowed to exit their vehicles while lining up for racing only when stopped and parked.
- Porta potties are strategically placed for convenience and safety with wash stations which are placed outside as well with hand sanitizer.
- A food truck will be available for patrons and staff to get food and drink during the day, lines require six-foot separation while waiting for food.
- Races start approximately at 9:30 a.m. and end at 5 p.m. sharp everyone must exit and leave the airport.
- MCSO will be on duty as well as AZ Rangers to help enforce Covid standards and keep safety and order to the races.

## **Gila Bend Town Events**

### **Racing Event Protocol**

Below are event rules Gila Bend has implemented until further notice. This should be distributed to all participants and compliance to these protocols should be administered by all participants. Failure to comply may result in denial of future special event applications.

- We ask that if you do not feel up to par, have a fever, or if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms; please stay home.
- If you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, we ask that you do not participate or attend the event until you have been cleared by a doctor or have had no symptoms for three days.
- We ask that if an attendee or event staff tests positive for COVID-19, they notify the event coordinator.
- All staff and volunteers should wear masks throughout the event.
- Attendees should wear face masks while in any facility and outdoors and not actively participating.
- Attendees should follow signage and guidelines for entering and exiting the facility, maintaining physical distancing of a minimum of six feet from other attendees.
- Spectators should be restricted to no more than two per participant if allowed spectators.
- Designate seating areas for spectators that are away from participants and encourage groups of ten or less while providing a minimum of six feet of distance.
- Events operating an entry table are encouraged to provide contactless payments.
- Participants should provide their own drinking water / individual water bottles or purchase from an approved vendor.
- Eliminate water stations or use pre-packaged food or beverage if possible.
- Participants should not share water bottles, towels, or equipment.
- Sunflower seeds/spitting should not be permitted.
- Physical contact between attendees such as high fives and handshakes is discouraged.
- Group meetings except the drivers meeting between event staff or participants and spectators is discouraged.
- Comprehensive sanitation protocols, including sanitizing event items before and after use and providing disposable disinfectant wipes, hand sanitizer, cleaner, or spray should be implemented.
- Create a route, if feasible, that eliminates two-way traffic.
- Assign participants an arrival check in station to check in for the event.
- Start participants in a manner that eliminates congregating at the start line and spaces them out during the race.

- Eliminate pre-race and post-race activities, including award ceremonies, that encourage people to congregate.
- Participants and spectators should leave the premises immediately after the event.
